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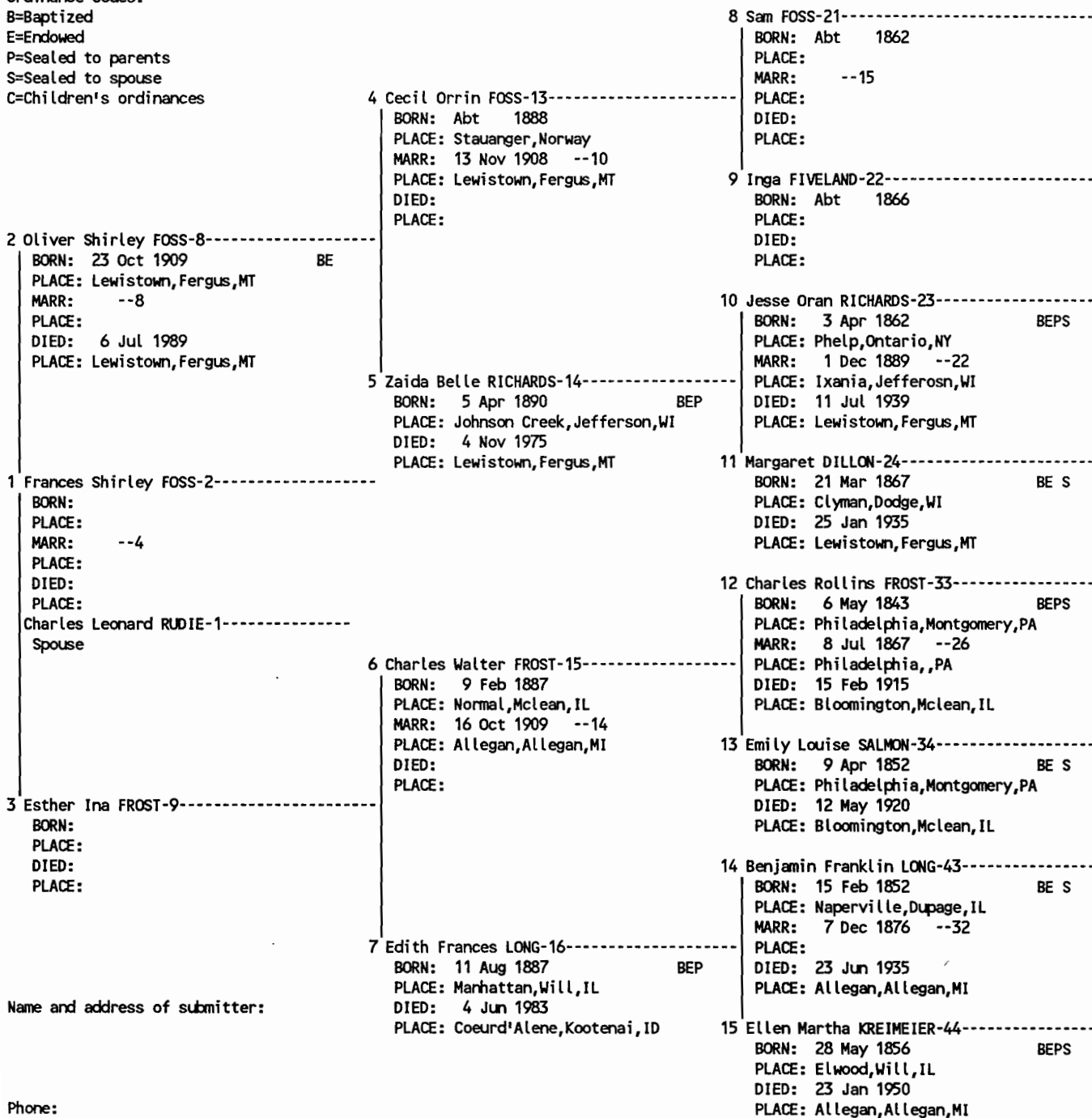

## HELP! HELP! HELP!

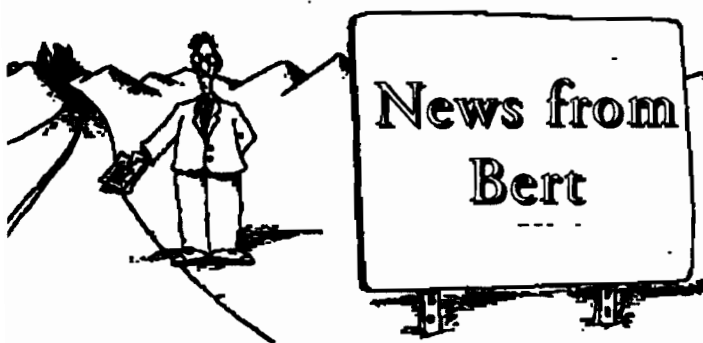

I will continue to send letters to key people in each family and would all of you who would like a copy of the newsletter, please send a stamped self-addressed, legal-sized envelope. If you use the number found above your name, it will help me file the envelope with the correct family. I don't have Velma anymore to remember who's who.

I have finally finished the research for this period, and I have found considerable information that moves Nicholas Van Dyke and Maria Van Orden closer to Morris County, New Jersey where James Frost lived in his early years. You will recall from last year's report that I had found documents indicating that Nicholas Van dyke moved from New Brunswick, New Jersey to New York city. He was listed as a gunsmith in the deed. I searched the land records of the County (Brooklyn), Queens County (Queens), which form the western side of Long Island, Richmond County (Stattan Island) and Westchester County north of Manhattan Island and King and Queens County. I did not find a reference to Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke.

This is where I left off last year. You will want to refer to my report of 1995 to get the details of this research. I also found that a Richard Van Dyke appeared in the 1790 census of North Carolina, and he was old enough to be Elizabeth's twin brother (Dirck) who was baptized the same day as Elizabeth in 1744. Of course, this raised the question as to whether he was Elizabeth Van Dyke's brother. I said that I would pursue this further next research period.

My research this period, then focused on finding out more about Richard Van Dyke in North Carolina, to see if I could determine is origins and possible connection to Elizabeth (Van Dyke) Frost, who also lived in North Carolina. I also wanted to locate the Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke family in New York or New Jersey. I felt that if I could pick up their trail again, I might be able to find out what happened to their daughter Elizabeth who was born in 1744. This is what I worked on this time, and though I still have not found the link yet, I did find out more about Richard Van Dyke of North Carolina, and I did find Nicholas and Maria again. Let me discuss what I found on Richard Van Dyke first.

### RICHARD VAN DYKE OF NORTH CAROLINA

Researching Richard Van Dyke was not easy, but I finally traced his movements to Spartanburg County, South Carolina. I found him first in Lincoln County, North Carolina in the 1790 census. According to the ages of himself and family members, I calculated his birth to be no later than 1750. He had a number of children, perhaps as many as ten. From the 1790 census, I calculated that he had at least six or seven sons and at least three daughters. Some of these sons were listed as being over 16 years of age in 1790 which would put some of them born around 1770 or a little before. If Richard was born around 1750, he would have only been between 18-20 years of age when he married. This seems a bit young, so I would put his birth year around 1745 instead. How about 1744 in New Jersey? Unfortunately, these early censuses do not give a place of birth for these children, but my guess is that they were probably born in New Jersey or Pennsylvania.

Richard shows up for the first time in Lincoln County in 1785, where he purchased property. He was there until 1790 because he appeared in the census of this county. sometime between 1790 and 1810 he moved to Spartanburg County, South Carolina, and I believe this is where he died sometime around 1817. In court records of Spartanburg County South Carolina. I found the following reference to Richard Van Dyke: Book P. page 307, 1817.

*I Richard Van Dike of Spartanburg, County, South Carolina have constituted and appointed and by these presents do make constitute, and appoint my son John Van Dyke my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name recover a bond of \$100 from Samuel Long, J.M. Lewis, and Peter R. Booker.*

I did not find Richard in the 1820 census of Spartanburg County, so I assume he died between 1817 and 1820. If he is the Richard born in 1744 at New Brunswick, he would have been 73 in 1817. The amazing part about the research I did on this man is that I have not yet been able to discover the name of his wife, nor have I been able to ascertain the names of all his children. I know that he had a son John and James. I think he had a son named Henry, and after doing the research this time, I am not sure that he had a son Joseph, as I indicated in my last report. My research on this Richard and his sons took me into Jefferson County, Tennessee, where I believe his sons James and Henry settled. John, James and Henry are such prominent names in the Van Dyke family. Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke named sons by these names and it appears Richard did too. I would like to do more research on this family because if I could identify the names of his wife and children, I could probably find out where they came from in New York or New Jersey. If any of his children lived to be recorded in the 1850 census, this census gives the date of birth. Wouldn't it be interesting to find one of Richard's children who was born in the 1770's recorded in the 1850 census. Would this help establish his origins or what?! What if they said New Jersey? We would know where to begin looking for Richard and his wife before they show up in North Carolina records in 1785. I wonder if Richard moved directly to Lincoln County, or he settled in another county first, like Rockingham or Guilford County.

In my extensive research in North Carolina records this time, I also came across a Henry Van Dyke who lived in Granville County, which is to the east of Guilford County. This caught my interest because Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke's last son was named Henry. isn't this interesting? I did not find him in the census at first. I found him in tax lists that had been indexed. It appears that Henry was in Granville County from at least 1765 or earlier, so I wonder about his being connected with Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke. From documents I found concerning this man, it appears that he came out of Virginia. If that is the case, he was in North Carolina too early to make a connection with Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke. I will not treat this lightly however. I will pursue this further if some of the other things do not yield results.

There are a number of things that I would still like to do to trace Richard Van Dyke, and I will pursue this with the intent of tracing his children further, especially the ones that moved to Tennessee. If they live to be recorded in the 1850 census, I think this will help us trace their earlier origins. If I can link Richard up with Nicholas and Maria, this will be another piece in the puzzle, and will support my theory that he is Elizabeth's brother.

#### **NICHOLAS AND MARIA VAN DYKE IN NEW JERSEY**

Now, let me get into the most interesting part of the research I did this time. Again, you will want to read the report from last year to get the details of what I did then. I

simply picked up with the research where I left off last year. Just to review and set the stage for this report, you will recall that Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke had two children baptized in the church at Harlingen, New Jersey between 1730 and 1733. This place is in the Middlesex County. They then moved to New Brunswick, which is also in Middlesex County where they had the rest of their children baptized, including their twins Elizabeth and Richard (Dirck). These other children were baptized between 1734 and 1746 (see enclosed family group sheet). I have been able to find them in New Brunswick until at least 1750. Sometime between this date and 1769, Nicholas and Maria moved to New York City. A deed that I sent you with last year's report indicates that they sold their property in New Brunswick to a man named John McIntyre. The deed, as you will notice, is dated in 1750, but was not recorded until 1769. I am not sure the reason for this, but in 1750, it states that he was of the city of New York. The deed also states that Nicholas Van Dyke was a gunsmith. This becomes important as my research progressed this time.

Now, I spent a good deal of time trying to find Nicholas and Maria in the records of counties that surround the city of New York. It is funny how your mind runs in a certain channel, and at times, it can actually impede progress. Well, that's what happened. I concentrated on the counties I mentioned above in trying to find this couple. It did not enter my head that there were counties of the west side of New York that are today just part of the greater New York area. I speak of Newark, New Jersey and other cities on the New Jersey side of greater New York. What actually prompted me to consider these was some temple work that appeared in the IGI. This work was performed in the Logan temple in 1922 by a man named Peter Van Orden. The names he did included some Van Dykes. In fact, one of the names was for a John who was given an exact birthdate of October 26, 1732. On the IGI it gave his place of birth as Hackensack, New Jersey. He did work for a Nicholas Van dyke as well, who was "living in 1727". This had more than passing interest because it looked like this man was doing work for part of the family of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke. This was confirmed to me when I compared John Van Dyke's birthday as Peter Van Orden gave it with the birth date recorded on the family group sheet of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke. Notice that their son John was born October 26, 1732, the same day as Peter Van Orden gave when he did John's temple work (see enclosed updated family group sheet for Nicholas and Maria).

This was the first time I connected Nicholas and Maria Van dyke with this part of New Jersey. I checked the original temple records to see if there was more information given. I discovered that only one of the entries had Hackensack recorded in the birth place column, and that was not the one for John Van Dyke born in 1732. whoever extracted these names from the record put Hackensack down as the birth place for every one of them including John Van Dyke, but this was not the case. Nothing was given next to John's name as far as a place of birth was concerned, but



because the birth date was given exactly, there was no question that he was doing work for the son of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke.

This information, though misleading, got me looking in the right place. I decided to look in the counties of New Jersey to the west of New York City for Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke and their family. Hackensack is in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (see the enclosed map for the location of this county and others that I subsequently searched). To make a long story short, I did not find Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke in this county, but I did move on to Essex County, which is next door to Bergen County. This is where things began to open up in a big way. What attracted my attention first of all were some tax lists that listed a Francis and Nicholas Van Dyke living in Newark Township in Essex County. Note how close Newark is to New York City. Only the Holland Tunnel separates Newark, New Jersey from New York City today. Who was this Nicholas anyway? Could he be the one who resided at New Brunswick for many years and later in New York City? At first I was skeptical but I had to find out enough about him to say he was not the right one. I couldn't go just by feelings. Well, the more I found out about this Nicholas, the more certain I became that he was the one who lived in New Brunswick and New York City. Let me explain. I concentrated my research almost exclusively in Essex County from this point on, and I was able to determine that his father was **Francis Van Dyke**, not John Van Dyke, as I had originally stated in my report of last year. I found the will of Francis Van Dyke, and he mentions his sons Nicholas and Francis Van Dyke, plus some daughters named Elizabeth, Maritje (Maria) and Hannah. One of the things that drew my attention to this is the fact that Francis Van Dyke was a **gunsmith**? Remember, from the deed of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke that I sent you last year, that Nicholas was also a gunsmith too! This really caught my attention. I enclose a copy of his will for your records, and I quote a summary of it here:

*18 August, 1750. The will of Francis Van Dyke of Essex County, New Jersey, gunsmith. Children: Nicholas, Francis, Elizabeth Broadbury, Marritje Van Winckle and Hannah. Land in Newark Township bought by Jonathan Seers bounded N. by second river, E., by Paysayack (Passaic) River. Personal Estate to son-in-law Richard Broadbury also, sole executor. Witnesses: Adrian Post, Abraham Gerritse, and James Billington. Proved: Augsut 24, 1752. Book F, pg. 63.*

This will set the stage for what I found on each of these children and whom they married. Elizabeth Bradbury (or Broadbury) also left a will, which I quote here. She again mentions her brothers Nicholas and Francis. but she also mentions some nieces and nephews, which, at first caused some confusion. She mentioned an Elizabeth Van Dyke, a niece which sounded like it might be Nicholas' daughter, and if it was, there went my theory about her marrying James Frost and moving south to North Carolina.

*February 6, 1773. Elizabeth Bradbery of Newark, New Jersey. To niece Hannah Van Dyke daughter of my brother Nicholas Van Dyke 100*

*pounds. Niece Elizabeth, wife Derick Van Outen, interest of 30 pounds during her life, and if she die w/o children, then, to be paid to Elizabeth, the daughter of my niece, Fitiz (Sophia) Van Ripen when she is 18. To said Elizabeth Van Ripen 33 pounds when 18. To said Fitia and Elizabeth Van Dyke, daughter of my brother Francis Van Dyke 50 pounds each. All rest of goods both real and personal to my brothers Nicholas and Francis Van Dyke and children of my sister Mary Van Winckle. Executors: brothers Nicholas and Francis. Proved February 20, 1773. Liber K Page 527.*

Now, at first glance it is hard to figure out some relationships because he mentions two Elizabeth's in this will. One is Elizabeth, the wife of Derick Van Outen (Houten), and other is Elizabeth Van Ripen. The latter is not hard to figure out because she is the daughter of Fitia (or Sophia) Van Ripen. Fitia is the daughter of Francis Van Dyke. That is clearly stated in the will, but who was the Elizabeth, wife of Derick Van Outen? Was she the daughter of Nicholas Van Dyke or Francis Van Dyke. This concerned me for a while, but the key to straightening this out is the phrase from the will "The **said** Fitia and Elizabeth, daughters of my brother Francis Van Dyke." "The said..." implies that they had been spoken of already in the will. Elizabeth Van Ripen was never a Van Dyke. She was the daughter of Sophia Van Ripen, who was a Van Dyke before marriage. The only other Elizabeth spoken of in this will Was Elizabeth, the wife of Derick Van Outen. She is the Elizabeth referred to here as the other daughter of Francis Van Dyke, besides Sophia.

Okay, so I am still in business looking for Elizabeth Van Dyke, the daughter of Nicholas Van Dyke. I don't even know for sure whether the Nicholas I am tracing in Essex County is the one who had a daughter Elizabeth and lived at one time in New Brunswick. I do know, however that Nicholas Van Dyke of New Brunswick had a daughter Hannah (Johanna in the christening entry, but Hanna and Johanna are used interchangeably). So reference to Hanna in this will does not conflict with anything we know about Nicholas Van Dyke of New Brunswick. He did have a daughter Hannah (or Johanna). There is one more will left by another sister to Nicholas and Francis Van Dyke. It was left by Hendrica Van Giesen.

*February 9, 1768. The will of Hendrica Van Giesen, the widow of Hendrick Van Giesen of Essex County, New Jersey. To Nephew Fransose Van Winkle 50 pounds. Niece Anoiche, wife of Hendrick Van Blarracham 50 pounds. My house and land, where I live, to be appraise. The rest of real and personal property to go to my bothers and sisters, Nicholas and Fransose Van Dyke and the widow Bradbury and Van Winkle. Executors: Nicholas and Fransos Van Dyke. Witnesses: Mary Brunett, Mary Wane and William Burnett. Proved February 16, 1768 Liber page 260.*

The information about her house and lands become important later on because the deeds reveal that several of the nieces and nephews inherited this property.

I found one other document that pertains to this family among the wills and administrations. There was a Francis Van Dyke who died intestate, and he was from New Brunswick at the time of his death. His wife's name was Sophia and the court appoints his son-in-law Abraham Van Doren (Dorn) to be the administrator of his estate. Now, is this Francis the brother of Nicholas and one mentioned in all of the wills above, and if it is, what is he doing in New Brunswick? He is supposed to be living around Newark Township in Essex County, not New Brunswick in Middlesex County. This was cleared up in searching the deeds of Essex County. You will never guess who was mentioned in the division of Hendrica Van Giesen's house and lands. Abraham Van Doren, Francis Van Dyke's son-in-law!! Here's our connection between the family in Essex County and New Brunswick. Let me summarize the deed for you.

*16 June, 1801. Indenture between James Van Dyke and Catherine his wife and John Van Dyke and Anna his wife of the county of Essex on the one part and Francis Van Winkle of Essex County on the other part paid \$1.00 to John and James Van Dyke for two pieces of property in the lands against the lawful demand of the said John and James Van Dyke and their wives as well as against the claims of their brother Francis Van Dyke...Indemnify nominate and discharge the said Francis Van Winkle together with Abraham Van Doren, Benjamin Van Doren, Derick Hagen, Frederick Van Leuwen and each of them, their heirs, executors and administrators from and against all manner of claims and demands against the personal estate of Hendrica Van Giesen and Elizabeth Bradbury deceased.*

This deed brings in some new elements because now we are dealing with the next generation. Francis Van Winkle was the son of Mary Van Winkle, the sister of Nicholas and Francis Van Dyke. I am not sure who Benjamin Van Dorn is, but Abraham Van Dorn married Francis and Shophia Van Dyke's daughter Maritje or Maria. I know Frederick Van Leuwen is related through marriage to the Van Dykes.

I went back to the baptismal register of the first Dutch Reformed Church of New Brunswick to see what I could find in these records, now that I had a few names to work with. I have photocopied the whole register, which covers from 1717 to 1760. Francis and Sophia Van Dyke have two or three children christened in this church. Of course Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke have most of their children christened here, and Abraham and Maria Van Dorn have children baptized in this church. Frederick Van Leuwen also has children baptized here too. There is no doubt that the Van Dyke family of Essex County had very strong ties with the town of New Brunswick in Middlesex County. This alone suggests that the Nicholas we are dealing with in Essex County is the same one that resided in New Brunswick and was married to Maria Van Orden.

Still, I had not been able to specifically make this connection, at least where he is identified with his wife Maria. I searched deeds of Essex County, and I found a number of deeds relating to the Van Dyke family in this county.

Several referred to a John and James Van Dyke, plus one or two connected them with Francis Van Dyke. It appeared that all of them were brothers, and at first I suspected them of being the sons of Francis Van Dyke, but I did not know for sure. Nicholas and Maria had sons named John, James, and Francis. I enclose a photocopy of the notes I made on the references to the grantor and grantee indexes of deeds in Essex County. You can see there are a number of deeds. The one I quoted above that pertains to Hendrica Van Giesen's estates is included in the list. I read them all, and I was able to establish that John, James and Francis Van Dyke were brothers, but who was their father? I found this out from the following deed which I quote in full here.

### **Francis Van Dyk and Wife to John and James Van Dyk**

*This indenture made in the year of our Lord One thousand and seven hundred and eighty two between Francis Van Dyk and Elizabeth his wife of Leona River in the County of Essex and State of New Jersey of the one part and James Van Dyk and John Van Dyk of the same state the other part. Witnesseth that the said Francis Van Dyk and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of 800 pounds lawful money of the state of New York to them in hand paid by the said James Van Dyk and John Van Dyk at or before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt ? hereby acknowledged do hereby acquit, release, and discharge them the said James Van Dyk and John Van Dyk, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever by these presents and for and in consideration of a certain release from them the said James Van Dyk and John Van Dyk to him the said Francis Van Dyk of equal date ? with them ? Have bargained, sold, aliened, enffeeofed, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do clearly and absolutely grant bargain ? release and confirm unto them, the said James Van Dyke and John Van Dyk their heirs and assigns forever, one third part of all that farm or plantation adjoining Passaick river near the third river and adjoining the farm of Abraham Van Giesen, north and south in the township of Newark in the county of Essex and state of New Jersey. Also one third part of the wood land known by the name of Burwell Batten? Joining north on land of Michael D. Freeland, east on land of James Wells North on lands in possession of Abraham Van Riper. Also, one third part of a piece of land lying at a place called Stone House in the same township aforesaid, being in the possession of ?, Abraham and Richard Van Giesen and ? Van Winkle. Also, one third part of the south Salt Meadow, eight acres each, lying in the great meadow one lot below the ? spot of Newark near the river ferry. The other lying and adjoining maple Isle? Creek, together with all and singular the houses, buildings edifices barns, stables, courts, orchards, gardens, fences, woods, underwoods, commons, common of pasture ways, paths passages, water courses ?, casements, profits, commodities, advantages, hereditaments, and appurtenances whatsoever occupied and enjoyed accepted to be known as part, parcel or belonging to the same for which they have rec'd from Nicholas Van Dyk to the said Francis Van Dyk bearing date twenty second day of June in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty one and also all the estate right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever both in law and equity of him the said Francis Van Dyk and Elizabeth his wife of in and to the same and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances. To have and to hold all the said mentioned and every part and parcel thereof unto the said James Van Dyk and John Van Dyk their heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto interchangeably put their hands and seals the day and year first above written.*

*Sealed and delivered in the presence of

Other deeds, which include John and James Van Dyke, but not Francis, indicate that John and James are brothers. This deed implies very strongly that Nicholas Van Dyke is their father, since they received the land from him. It also suggests that Nicholas Van Dyke died between 1781 and 1782 since the land went to the three sons in 1781, and they are settling on the distribution a year later. As I mentioned before, Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke had sons named John and James. They have identified their child Frances, baptized in 1737 as a girl, when in fact, I suspect it was a son who was baptized then. The other child identified as Nicholas and Maria's is Hannah, and they had a daughter by this name. The circumstantial evidence pointing to the Nicholas living in Essex County being the same Nicholas Van Dyke that lived in New Brunswick is very strong. In fact, the evidence convinces me that it is. Still, I have not found any sources in Essex County that includes Maria's name.

There is one deed that I am afraid we never will be able to see, which I am certain would answer a lot of questions. The following reference was found in the mortgagee index of East Jersey deeds.

Nichlas Van Dick & al    Liber A pg. 296 dated 1773

The state kept track of the deeds from the early years of the province until about 1790. The state was divided into West and East Jersey. There were no county deed registers before about 1790. The deed I did find and quoted above was actually made in 1782, and it got recorded in the county deeds of Essex County but it did not get recorded there until 1813, probably when the three brothers actually decided to do something about the property. That is the only reason that a deed that early was found in the County deed registers. I am quite certain the deed recorded in 1773 in the name of Nicholas Van Dyke pertains to the man living in Essex County, and it is so enticing because of the "& al". What will you bet Nicholas and Maria were dividing their lands among their children. It makes you wonder who was mentioned in this deed doesn't it? It is too much to think that his daughter Elizabeth Frost would be mentioned in it. Or, if nothing else mentioning his daughter Elizabeth so we might get a clue as to what happened to her, whether she went to North Carolina or not. Unfortunately, we may never get the chance. The actual Liber A, or Book A was apparently destroyed by fire. There was a note in the Family History Library Catalog to that effect. This was a real let down. I can just picture Elizabeth being mentioned in this deed. Then, we would have known with more certainty whether to trace this family further.

In thinking about the possible connection between Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke and our Elizabeth Frost in North Carolina, there are some things in all that I have found that gets us closer to where they could meet and marry. Notice from the enclosed map of New Jersey that Newark in Essex County is only about 15 miles from Morristown in Morris County. We are pretty certain that

James Frost was from Morris County before he moved to North Carolina. We now have Elizabeth, the daughter of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke, within a few miles of where James lived. Fifteen miles in those days could be traversed within a few hours.

On top of the distance between James Frost and Elizabeth Van Dyke diminishing, I also noted that the occupation of Nicholas Frost, a gunsmith, is very much similar to what James Frost's occupation was, that of forge smith. Nicholas would need the iron made by James Frost to manufacture his fire arms. And, I am pretty sure Nicholas would have a better chance of getting the iron he needed by going the Morris County rather than trying to find it in Essex County.

The circumstantial evidence supporting the movements of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke has helped me follow this family around New Jersey. I believe I can find more on this family, and hopefully find Maria mentioned in further research. I very much want to examine the Dutch Reformed Church records of Newark in Essex County to see if I can find more on Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke. Hopefully, I can find their burials which will give the proof I need.

This couple had numerous children, and I have accounted for four of them this time, namely Johannah (Hannah), John, James, and Francis. That leaves Sophia, Nicholas, Maria, Elizabeth, Dirck, and Henry to find. I find it interesting that in my research, none of the younger children are mentioned. Do you suppose that they, meaning Elizabeth Dirck (Richard), and Henry went elsewhere, like North Carolina? It is interesting to me that the only Van Dykes I have traced in North Carolina are an Elizabeth (our ancestor), Richard and Henry Van Dyke. We just need to find out if these are the children of Nicholas and Maria Van Dyke. There is so much to do, and I am encouraged to finish the research, mainly because I have found no conflicts in the information so far. Usually, by now, if the theory is not correct, conflicting data begins to appear to make you question the direction the research is taking. But, so far this has not happened. I just wish that I had more time, but I had to quit. I just keep working on the problem because it is so much fun. Every new clue just whets your appetite for more, but I just had to quit this time because it was beginning to affect other work that I needed to get done. I am excited and feel there is an answer to this line, just like I feel there is an answer to the Frost Line. I will pursue this line further next period.

And these defendants further in answering say, that they do .... said Nicholas Van Dyke fraudulently and deceitfully took possession of the said ....estate and they do expressly aver that the said Jacobus Jeralman surrendered the possession of such part of the premises as he had in occupation arguably to contract. And the said Francis Van dyke one of these defendants further in answering says, that the said Nicholas Van Dyke, his said father claimed all or the greater part of the real estate of the said Hendrica Van Gieson as her heir at law and that a year or two before the late war, that the said Francis Van Winkle went to New York and applied to the said Nicholas Van Dyke to some.... promise with him, respecting the homestead of the said Hendrica Van Gieson. 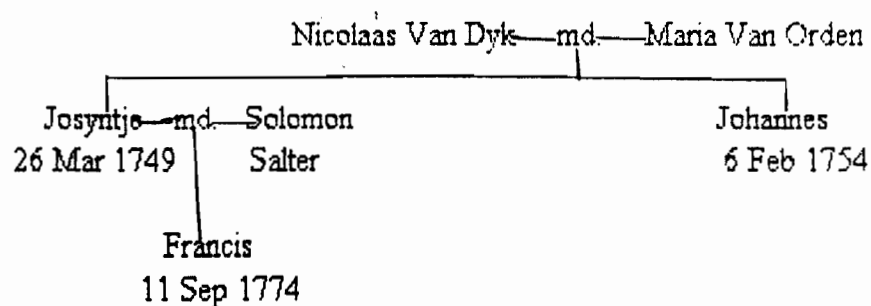
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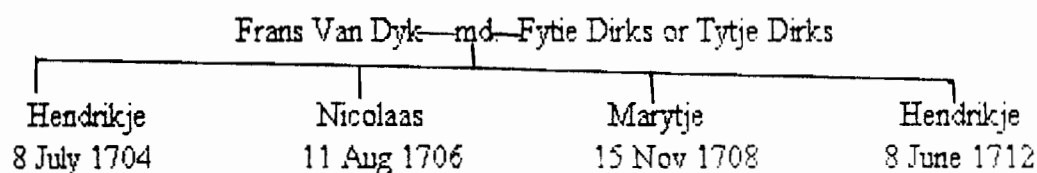
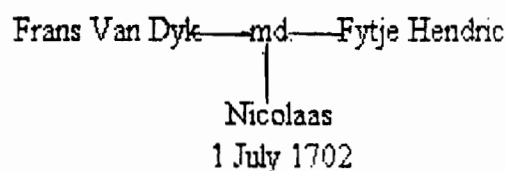
